

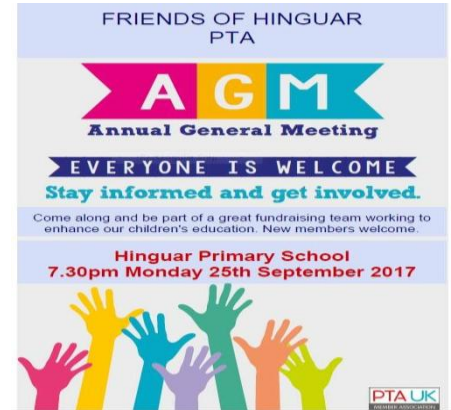


# HINGUAR SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

## **Peanut Allergy**

There are pupils in our school who has a severe **peanut allergy**. If they come into contact with peanuts they will suffer a severe allergic reaction which could be life threatening. The safety of all our children is paramount to us at Hinguar so if you would please help us by voluntarily adhering to the following food allergy safety guidelines:-

### **Please do not send in:**

- Any food items to be eaten as snacks with ingredient labels indicating they contain or may contain peanuts or peanut butter.
- Home baked goods that contain nuts

**ALSO** If your child ate foods with peanuts or peanut butter for breakfast, please make sure that his/her hands are washed with both soap and water before leaving for school. Remember, the safest way to reduce peanut allergy risks in our classroom, is to take the time to read the ingredient label carefully. We thank you for your support
